SCOOP lets you get oxygen just where you need it – directly into your lungs. It uses a small catheter inserted into your wind pipe to deliver oxygen, eliminating the need for an irritating or embarrassing nasal cannula.

## Get more from your oxygen therapy.

Most people find it difficult to wear a nasal cannula around the clock, because it often causes soreness or sinus problems. But SCOOP puts an end to all of that.

SCOOP delivers oxygen right to your lungs, 24 hours a day. Because it's a more efficient way to get the oxygen you need, you'll need less oxygen. SCOOP users can typically reduce their resting oxygen flow rate by 50% to 60%. It allows you to be more active because your body is working more efficiently.

## Live a better, longer life.

Studies have shown that patients receiving oxygen through a SCOOP transtracheal catheter, live significantly longer – an average of 2 years longer than patients who are clinically similar but using a nasal cannula. And with SCOOP, you can enjoy a better quality of life. You may sleep better, enjoy eating more and take pleasure again in the little things such as putting on make-up, going out in public or even kissing a loved one.

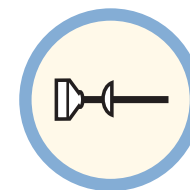
## Both patients and doctors agree.
